#### **Parking:**

There are only 44 parking spaces directly at the hotel. However there are an additional 300 spaces at LBBW Bank (Landes Bank Baden Württemberg), which is situated opposite the hotel. Please visit the hotel website for details.

In Europe's largest zoological-botanical garden Wilhelma you can gaze at the 9000 animals and exotic plants, exquisite garden art and architecture in the Moorish style.

### Travel by car

From the south (Salzburg A1 or Munich A8 resp.): Take exit 52b "Stuttgart-Degerloch" and stay on the B27 direction "Stuttgart-Degerloch / Stuttgart centre" until you reach the exit "Friedrichstrasse". This takes you directly to the "Heilbronner Strasse". After 0.5 kilometres you will see the ARCOTEL Camino on the left hand side of the road. Drive to the next set of traffic lights and make a U-turn on the Heilbronner Strasse. The hotel is now on your right. Drive past and turn right as the entrance is at the back of the hotel.

Parking: Please be sure to look up the parking areas.

From the north (Berlin A9 / Nürnberg A6): Take exit 38 - cross "Weinsberg" on the A81 direction "Stuttgart / Weinsberg". Then you take exit 17 "Stuttgart-Zuffenhausen". On the B10 you drive in the direction of "Stuttgart-Zuffenhausen / Stuttgart centre". Take the exit "Ulm / Stuttgart centre" and continue on the B27, which takes you directly to the "Heilbronner Strasse". After approx. 6.3 kilometres you will reach the ARCOTEL Camino. The hotel is on your right. Drive past and turn right as the entrance is at the back.

### Travel by train

The Stuttgart central station is a seven-minute walk from the ARCOTEL Camino. Take the exit from the north. Pass the state bank Baden-Württemberg / LBBW on your right. The pedestrian crossing before the fitness studio "Fitness Company" brings you to the hotel entrance on the Heilbronner Strasse.

### Travel by airplane

Stuttgart Airport is about 18 km from the hotel. You can get to and from the airport by taxi, which takes approx. 20 minutes or by train, which takes approx 30 minutes. The train operating between the airport and the central railway station is the rapid-transit railway line S2 or S3.
