RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) For applications, a registered teacher must fully complete the attached entry form, including the following information:
 - Dance School and teacher contact information
 - Dancer's name and date of birth
 - Grades to be taken in Rome and the fee in €
 - List of previous **three** examiners
 - For grades 9 and 10, list of modern set dances and speed (not compulsory information)
- 2) **Closing date for entries is Monday August 5th 2019** to ensure an accurate timetable can be provided.
- 3) Only **Basic Steps** may be danced in the Preliminary grade and Grades 1, 2 & 3.
- 4) **All candidates must produce previous reports before proceeding to higher grades. Please bring these to the exam.**
- 5) **40** bars of music are to be danced to for all Reels, Single or Hop Jigs, Light Jigs, Slip Jigs, Heavy Jigs and Hornpipes.
- 6) St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Garden of Daisies, Job of Journeywork, King of the Fairies, Three Sea Captains, and Jockey to the Fair **must be performed in a traditional style and manner.**
- 7) The same set dance must not be performed in more than one of Grades 9 and 10.
- 8) Candidates must be able to adequately demonstrate practical and theoretical knowledge of all ceili dances as per "Ár Rincí Céilí" for Grades 5 - 10. **They will not be asked to teach them.**
- 9) A dancer must take all grades in order, beginning with Grade 1 - the Preliminary grade is optional. However, a candidate may only attempt a **maximum of 3 consecutive Grades at any one sitting.**

- 10) **Grade exams must be examined by at least 4 examiners up to and including grade 10.**
- 11) Each grade must be passed before a candidate may attempt the next grade.
- 12) Dance costumes should not be worn.
- 13) All 12 Grade Examinations must be completed to be eligible to apply for the TCRG Examination effective from January 1st 2018.
- 14) **A three month period** must elapse before the next grade is attempted.
- 15) A dancer would be permitted to retake any grade for a better score upon submission of a specific written request to the Udarás Scrúdaithe, with the understanding that the second result would replace the earlier one and that the dancer would be required to pay the usual fee for the grade being taken.

Venue

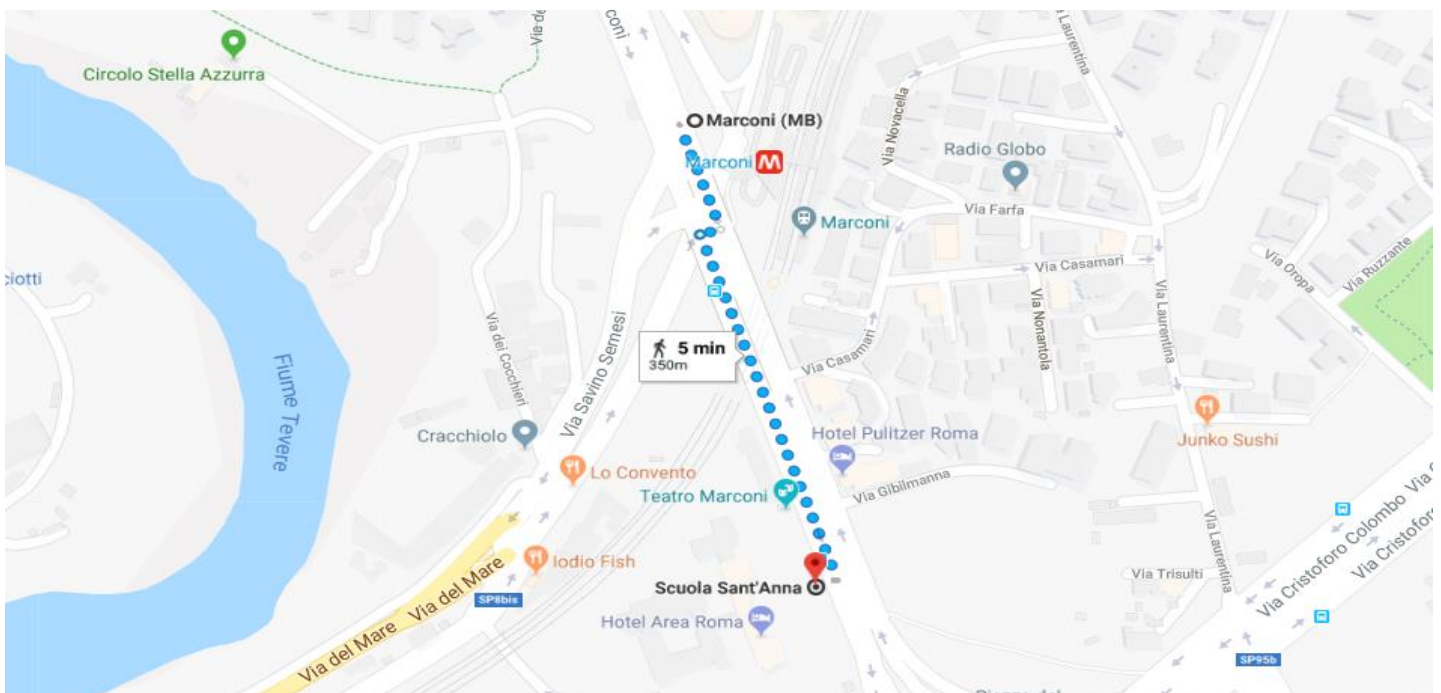
Istituto S.Anna is in the South West of Rome, in Viale Guglielmo Marconi 700.

A changing room and an extra room for warm up and practice will be provided, as well as water, juices and light snacks. Our friendly ROIS Dance School staff will guide you through the exam experience and assist you with any need.

How to get there

By subway: Istituto S.Anna is 350 mt. from the subway stop “Marconi” on the blue “B” line.

By bus: n. 170. This bus can be easily taken from Central Train Station “Termini”, direction “P.le Agricoltura” (get off at “Marconi/Gibilmanna” stop); n. 791 (get off at “Marconi/Gibilmanna” stop), Subway and bus tickets can be bought at ticket machines, kiosks and tobacco shops.



Airport connections

Rome has two airports: Fiumicino (South West of Rome) and Ciampino (South East of Rome). In both cases, connections to the city centre are provided by bus services. Fiumicino is also directly connected to city centre by train (Leonardo Express, €14 one way). ROIS staff are happy to help you to find your best travel arrangement.
